### WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL – MONDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> MARCH

Following the government announcement, all class bubbles will fully re-open to **ALL PUPILS** from **MONDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> MARCH**. We look forward to welcoming all pupils back to school once again in line with the same safety and hygiene rules we have used previously. We ask for your continued cooperation with these processes to help us ensure safe entry and exit for all pupils each day.

#### Morning Entry (Between 8:30am and 8:50am) – (Pupils ONLY)

- Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 6 pupils enter the school through “**Beaconsfield Road**” from 8:30am
- Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 & ARP Classes enter the school through “**Oswald Road**” from 8:30am
- **ALL PUPILS** need to have arrived by 8:50am (This is the official school start time)

#### Afternoon Pupil Collection (From 3:10pm for ARP Parents/ 3:15pm for main school) (One-way system)

- All parents/ carers will enter from the “**Beaconsfield Road**” entrance (like previously)
- There is no need to arrive very early and “queue” (Your children are safe with us).
- At 3:10pm we will let parents/ carers collecting ARP pupils enter
- From 3:15pm we will let main school parents enter the site to collect pupils and then leave through “**Oswald Road**” gates.
- Reception classes are collected directly from their classroom (through NURSERY GATES) (Please collect Reception age pupils FIRST)

As I said before, I know it is inconvenient for families with more than one child in school to have different drop-off points but I am confident you will work with us to maintain safety and separation of year groups. We will only keep these measures in place for the minimum amount of time required. Once your drop off your child each day please leave the gate area immediately so that other children can enter the school. This is not a place for having chats where you are not socially distant.

#### SOCIAL DISTANCING:

I need to remind **ALL PARENTS & CARERS** to keep following social distancing when dropping off and collecting pupils from each gate. You **MUST** be wearing a **FACE COVERING** when you enter the school site. If you do choose to wait in a line (at the end of the day) please do keep 2m apart. This is for your safety and the safety of your children and others living in your house.

#### CONTINUED HELP IS NEEDED:

We know that some parents may again be anxious about returning to school, but it is very important that we get your children back learning and studying again as this will affect their lives as they grow up into adulthood. During the entire autumn term we did not have any Covid cases transmitted between pupils and staff in school. If everyone follows all the rules, school is a very safe place.

The government has also confirmed that **from MONDAY 8<sup>th</sup> MARCH**, school attendance is **COMPULSORY** for all pupils. If your child is not in school the usual absence and monitoring procedures will apply. As school attendance is compulsory staff will not be providing further home learning support after Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March. We will in the future be continuing to use the online learning skills/ platforms and programmes with assigned homework. Day to day lessons, teaching and support will now be taught in the classrooms.



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### **SCHOOL OFFICE ACCESS:**

Please note that there is no access to the school office for adults until after 9am each day when the last pupils have entered the site. If you are coming into the school office, **YOU MUST WEAR A FACE COVERING** and also undertake hand sanitisation upon entry

**Office hours will only be available from after 9:00am until 2:45pm.** Please do try to avoid any visits to the school office by either phoning or emailing ([admin@beaconsfield.ealing.sch.uk](mailto:admin@beaconsfield.ealing.sch.uk)).

**AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS:** In the autumn term we were able to restart some within year group bubbles. We will be looking to get a limited number of clubs running as quickly as possible as we know games, sports and activities outside have many positive benefits for pupils.

**BREAKFAST CLUB:** Due to staffing limitations at the present time we are currently unable to re-open the 'Breakfast Club'. We will be looking to re-start this provision from 7:30am each day as soon as possible.

**SWIMMING LESSONS:** Group swimming lessons are not yet permitted for school groups. As soon as group lessons resume we aim to start our swimming programme for KS2 pupils.

**"Loan IT Device Scheme":** Those families who were eligible for the 'loan IT device scheme' will be asked to return these devices, chargers and where included dongles and covers from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March. (*Please ensure that you have **NOT SAVED** usernames or passwords on devices*)

We are all hoping that with the plans outlined by the government this will have been the final lockdown. We are now planning for the remainder of this academic year and the entire year from Sept 2021 till July 2022 to support all pupils to re-engage fully with learning and recover back to where we all want them to be. Thank you all for your enormous and extremely valuable efforts to support learning at home over the past 12 months.
